

CMSM Monthly Meeting Minutes

May 9th, 2013

The meeting started at 6:33pm.

Attendance: The attendance sheet was passed out and 9 members were present this month.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer reported the club account contains \$1365 and that there are 8 members who have paid their club dues so far for this year. In preparation for TigerCon 2013, a payment of \$121 was made to restock trophy plaques.

Tuskegee Airmen Show : The event will be held on May 25th. Models for display will be needed by the 22nd of May. Any P-51, P-40's, B-17's, or B-24 aircraft models are needed for the event. Jack A. and Kent B. have volunteered to attend the event on behalf of the club.

Columbia Mall Display Kiosk : The club has been invited by the Columbia Mall to supply models for another display kiosk again this year. The kiosk will be down the hall from the food-court. All members are asked to loan any models they can. Approximately 20 models are needed, of all varieties. Set up will be on the evening of the 31st of May. The kiosk will be on display throughout August. There will again be club-interest slips plus this year it was decided to have 2 drawings for a free model kit. The first drawing will be at mid-month, and the second at the end of the month.

Mustang Club Auto Show : The Mustang Club is having their yearly event on June 23rd. They have once again invited the club to set up a display tent at the event. The event location will (again) be at the Boone County Historical Society. After discussion, a number of members volunteered to loan model cars for display and to staff the tent for the event.

DBRL 3rd Floor Display : The Daniel Boone Regional Library has again asked the club to supply models for display in the 3rd floor display case. This years' theme is the The American Civil War. After discussion, it was decided it was unlikely the club would be able to participate this year, as no members present could

think of anyone in the club who had any civil war models. After further discussion it was pointed out that the Boone County Historical Society might be interested in some kind of display of Missouri Civil War models/events (diorama perhaps?). The hope was expressed that some members might consider finding and building some form of model kits and/or dioramas depicting the American Civil War, especially Missouri-oriented items.

TigerCon Committee : It was reported that more members are needed for the committee. The club is rapidly approaching the time when preparations for the 2013 event must begin. If any member would like to serve on the TigerCon Committee for 2013, please contact Colin Smialek by the first week in June.

Embroidered Hats : It was reported to the club that “Stitches in the Ink” will embroider the club logo on hats or tee shirts for the club. The club can provide the shirts or “Stitches...” can provide them. Items are \$7 each after an initial, one-time set-up fee of \$50. The club would provide the existing club logo design which would then be on file with “Stitches...”. After discussion, little interest was expressed at this time. It was noted that the offer will continue to be available for some time, and if interest picked up at a later date, the club could still provide the logo and the set-up fee.

Club Clinic : The members present took a short break and then gathered for this month’s presentation on “Putty Techniques”. Several examples of filling in seams with different types of putty (and even CA glue) were demonstrated and discussed.

Adjournment: Chairs and tables were put away and the meeting adjourned at 7:52pm.
