

CMSM Monthly Meeting Minutes

June 13th, 2013

The meeting started at 6:41pm.

Attendance: The attendance sheet was passed out and 11 members were present this month, including one new member. This month the club welcomed Paul "Pablo" B.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer reported the club account contains \$1240 after two TigerCon expenses were deducted.

KC Slammers Event Report : Two club members went to the KC Slammers contest event in St.Louis last month. They took with them club flyers and TigerCon flyers to hand out. They reported the event as being great, and having more attendance this year than last. There were however, fewer models; more people were entering, but each person was apparently bringing fewer models to events (a sign of the economy?). Also noted were that there were a greater number of smaller scale models than larger scale. The vendor area was reported as "positively hopping" with lots of activity.

TigerCon Report : The committee announced... the location for this year! This year TigerCon will be held at the Hickman High School in Columbia, Missouri, USA.

Central Missouri Mustang & Ford Club Event : It was reported that this year's event will be held on Sunday, June 23rd. CMSM is again invited to set up a tent and display car models (preferably Mustang's, of course). The club decided that this year there will again be a model kit giveaway. Several members volunteered to man the tent, provide models for display, supply the tent, or tables. The event will be held, as before, at the Boone County Historical Society.

Columbia Mall Display Kiosk : The club has been asked to provide models for a display kiosk at the Columbia Mall again. The kiosk will be down the hall from the Food Court. Models are needed to place in the kiosk for display. This year the club decided to hold two giveaway raffles for model kits. People who fill out an interest card will be eligible for either of the two drawings. First drawing will be held after two weeks, and the second another two weeks later.

Ideas for Future Club Clinics : After discussion, requests were added for “Toothbrush and Rubber Cement Spray” techniques for modeling splash marks. Another request was made for a session on using salt to simulate paint chips.

Club Clinic : The members present took a short break and then gathered for this month’s presentation on “Kit Bashing”. Colan showed off his kit-bashed short-bed truck (from two kits), while Jeff P. showed off an aircraft he’d been constructing from several kits.
